

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. DIVISIONS

1.1 There will be four divisions

- Mens Open
- Womens Open
- Mixed Open
- Senior Mixed (Over 35 Women / Over 40 Men)

1.2 Each Division will have eight, four or two pools depending on the number of nominations in each division.

1.3 The Games will be played in 2 x 15 minute halves with straight turnaround at half-time.

2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

2.1 MENS OPEN, WOMENS OPEN AND MIXED OPEN DIVISIONS

2.1.1 Each team is restricted to a maximum of 6 “current representative player” points

2.1.2 The points attaching to each “current representative player” are :

2.1.3 SENIOR MIXED (OVER 35 WOMEN / OVER 40 MEN)	20 years and under	0.25 points

2.1.3 SENIOR MIXED (OVER 35 WOMEN / OVER 40 MEN)

Australia or New Zealand	1.5 points
Qld or NSW	1.0 point
National Touch League Permit	0.75 points
State Region	0.25 points

- 2.1.4 If a person is a “current representative player” in more than one of the categories specified, the points to attach to that player are the highest points applying to a category in which the player has participated. Points applying to other categories will not also attach to the player.
- 2.1.5 A “current representative player” is a person who, since 1 January 2003, has been Selected to play and accepted selection in a Touch team representing Australia, New Zealand, Queensland, New South Wales, a National Touch League permit, a Queensland, New South Wales Region, a New Zealand Province in an official competition in the divisions listed in 2.1.2. This includes national, state, provincial and regional teams associated or affiliated with the Australian Touch Association, the National Touch Rugby Association (Australia) or their New Zealand equivalents.
- 2.1.6 Age criteria for Senior Mixed:- Over 35 Women - 35 on or before 31/12/05
Over 40 Men - 40 on or before 31/12/05

2.2 Player Numbers

- 2.2.1 Each team is restricted to registering and playing a maximum of 14 players.

2.3 Registration Forms

- 2.3.1 Fully completed registration forms and a deposit of \$200.00 must be submitted with the nomination form on or before the closing date of nominations (13/08/05). The balance must be paid at the Managers Meeting on the 3rd September.

2.4 Participation in Multiple Teams

- 2.4.1 Players may play in more than one Division.
- 2.4.2 Players must not play in more than one team in the same Division.

2.5 Ineligible Players

- 2.5.1 Random checks of eligible players will be conducted throughout the Tournament. Any Player or Team that violates player eligibility conditions may be disqualified from the Tournament at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.

3 Team Composition

- 3.1 Of the 14 players permitted to register and play in each team, a maximum of 6 may be on the field at any particular time.
- 3.2 In the Senior Mixed Division the maximum number of males on the field at any particular time is three. The minimum number of female players on the field at any particular time is one.

4 Rules and Regulations for Tournament

All Players must be currently registered with the Australian Touch Association. Players and Officials must play by the Touch Rules as laid down by the ATA. The Tournament Control Committee has the right to amend the Tournament Conditions at their discretion
